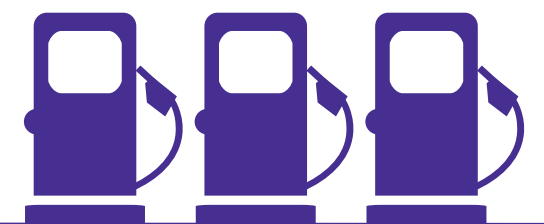
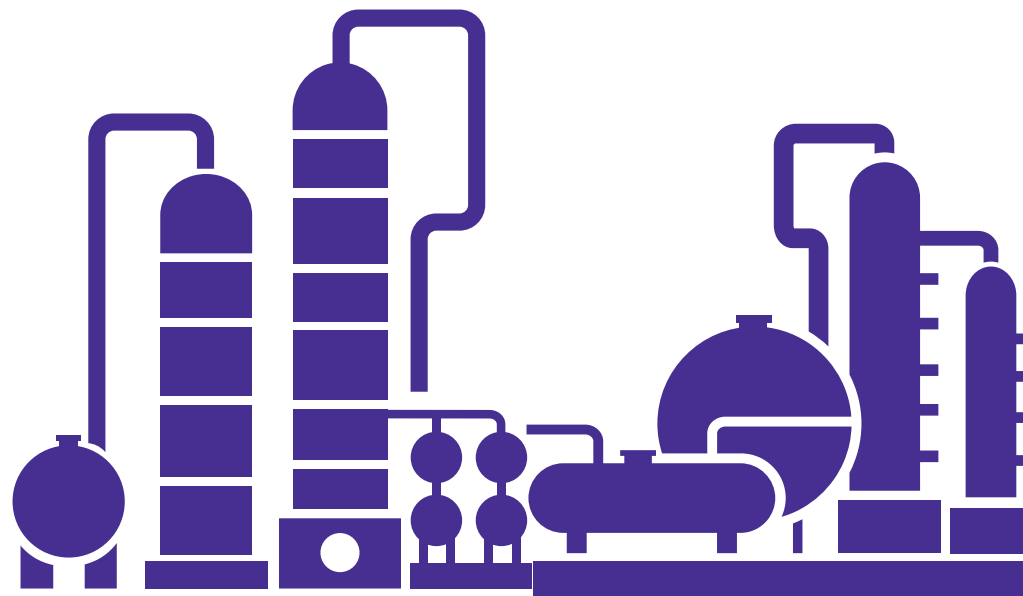


Smarter Forests, **Smarter Fuel**, Smarter Flights



FedEx is working with Red Rock Biofuels to turn forest waste into jet fuel. Creating a smarter fuel means we can deliver your packages more sustainably.



Discarded branches, bark and pine needles are gathered up from timber and saw mill operations in Lakeview, OR.

Recycling this waste reduces combustible materials from the forest floor and reduces the risk of forest fires.

Forest waste is transported to Red Rock Biofuels, where a combination of heat, pressure and reclaimed water produces a renewable biofuel that reduces carbon emissions.

48 million gallons of blended aviation fuel will be used at the FedEx Oakland hub starting in 2017.

This process also will create about 100 jobs in the local community.
