



David Ross

Regional President; Middle East, Indian Subcontinent and Africa (MEISA); FedEx Express

David Ross is the regional president of the Middle East, Indian Subcontinent and Africa (MEISA) region for FedEx Express. Based in Dubai, Ross leads over 11,000 FedEx Express and TNT team members, and is responsible for providing the strategic direction for the region.

Ross began his career with FedEx Express in Sydney, Australia, in 1992, managing the company's ground operations until he was promoted to managing director of Australasia and Pacific Islands in 1993. In 1994, Indonesia was added to his scope of responsibilities.

Ross moved to the position of managing director for Hong Kong and Macau in November 1995. As a result of his success in that role, he was promoted to vice president of the North Pacific region in September 1998, with responsibility for all corporate strategies and operations across Japan, Korea, and Taiwan.

In April 2011, Ross assumed the role of vice president, integration and domestic operations, in India. Shortly thereafter in August 2011, Ross was promoted to the position of senior vice president of operations for the MEISA region and moved to Dubai.

In February 2015, FedEx Express named Ross regional president of its MEISA region. The distinct MEISA region was formed in recognition of the increasing size, broader service offering, and greater growth opportunities represented by the region.
