David L. Cunningham, Jr., is chief operating officer and president, international, for FedEx Express, the world's largest express transportation company.

Effective February 1, 2017, Cunningham will become president and chief executive officer, FedEx Express.

He leads all customer-facing aspects of the company's U.S. operations and its international business, spanning more than 220 countries and territories across the globe. He also oversees FedEx Trade Networks and FedEx Supply Chain.

Cunningham directs the company's efforts to open markets, improve customs procedures, and support international economic policy reforms around the world.

Prior to his current role, he was regional president of the FedEx Express Asia Pacific Division in Hong Kong for 15 years, where he was responsible for developing and executing all corporate strategies and operations in one of the company's most dynamic operating divisions.

Cunningham joined FedEx in 1982 in operations at the FedEx Express World Hub in Memphis. In 1989, he was appointed manager of international financial planning and control for the Asia Pacific region. In 1992, he assumed the role of corporate managing director of worldwide financial planning in the U.S.

In 1994, Cunningham returned to the Asia Pacific region, serving first as CFO and vice president of finance, based in Hong Kong; then regional vice president of FedEx in South Pacific, based in Singapore; before becoming regional president in 1999.

Cunningham is currently a member of the Board of Governors of Junior Achievement Worldwide, a board member of the U.S.-China Business Council, and a board member of Christian Brothers University.

Cunningham holds a master's degree in marketing and a Bachelor of Science (Finance) from the University of Memphis.
